

## Professor Henry Woo

Professor Henry Woo is an international leader in urological surgery, and is positioned at the forefront of clinical and technological advances in the treatment of prostate diseases.

He is an Honorary Professor of Urology at the Australian National University (ANU) School of Medicine and Psychology, Canberra, and a Conjoint Professor at Western Sydney University (WSU), Sydney. Prof Woo is a Staff Specialist and Head of the Department of Urology at Blacktown Hospital in western Sydney. He also serves as Director of Uro-Oncology and Head of Robotic Surgery at the Chris O'Brien Lifehouse Comprehensive Cancer Centre.

Prof Woo graduated from the University of Sydney in 1985 with a Bachelor of Medicine, and Bachelor of Surgery. During this MBBS studies, he served on the Student Representative Council, University of Sydney Union Board and Sydney University Medical Society. He completed his Doctor of Medical Science in 2016.

Prof Woo is a Fellowship Elected Councillor at the Royal Australasian College of Surgeons (RACS), where he is also the Chair of Professional Standards. He also serves as a Board Director of the Australian and New Zealand Urogenital and Prostate (ANZUP) Cancer Trials Group, as well as the charitable Australasian Urological Foundation (AUF).

Prof Woo has research and clinical interest in the treatment of benign and malignant prostate disease. He has published extensively, and has more than 200 peer reviewed scientific papers and several book chapters. He is an Associate Editor of *Societie Internationale Urologie Journal*, and serves on the editorial boards of multiple international journals, including *Prostate Cancer and Prostatic Diseases*, *World Journal of Urology*, *European Urology Open Science*, *Prostate International*, *Asian Journal of Urology*, and *World Journal of Men's Health*.
